(Note: Tithe is from a Hebrew word which means 'tenth.' While all we have comes from the Lord, He permits us to use 9/10ths and asks us to return 1/10th to test our faithfulness and loyalty to Him. "All the tithe...IS the Lord's." When we pay our tithe, we are but returning to God what is already His. Genesis 14:18-20; 28:18-22)

(Note: The Levites were especially set apart for ministry to the Lord. Today, just as then, the tithe is to be used for the support of God's ministry throughout the world.) > 1Corinthians 9:13, 14; Matthew 10:5-10

10. Did Jesus recognize the principle of tithing? Luke 11:42

(Note: Tithe does little good for the giver when given for show or to earn favor with God. Jesus said the Pharisees did right in giving their tithe, but they did it from a wrong motive, and were neglecting the essential virtues, such as love, mercy, and faith. They needed a change of heart.)

11. Besides the tithe, what else did the children of Israel give to further the work of the Lord? Exodus 35:4-22

(Note: The tithe of our increase, a specified portion, is reserved by God for Himself. In addition to this the Bible speaks of freewill offerings which God's people give to Him. While the tithe supports the work of the ministry, as in ancient times, offerings support Christian education and other Christian outreach. > Exodus 25:2)

(Note: This tithe was set aside over the course of two years and was specifically for the poor and widow, the stranger and fatherless. We refer to is as a second tithe specifically for the same group today.)

(1Corinthians 9:10-15). Will you willingly follow God's commands and freely give?
