#### 1. WHAT should be our conduct one toward another?

"Love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous." 1Peter 3:8.

### 2. How many should we honor?

"Honor all men. Love the brotherhood." 1Peter 2:17.

#### 3. Whom should we salute?

"If ye salute your brethren only, what do ye more than others? do not even the publicans so?" **Matthew 5:47**.

### 4 What respect should be shown the aged?

"Thou shalt *rise up* before the hoary head, and *honor* the face of the old man." **Leviticus 19:32**. See **2Kings 2:23, 24**.

### 5. Whom especially should children honor?

"Honor thy father and thy mother." **Exodus 20:12**.

## 6. How should faithful gospel ministers be regarded?

"Let the elders that rule well be counted worthy of *double honor*." **1Timothy 5:17**.

# 7. What is the basis of true Christian courtesy?

"Charity [love] . . . is kind; . . . charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up, doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own." **1Corinthians 13:4, 5**.
